# KARATE PICNIC

### Where to Go

Use the map and follow the directions on the back to find the park.

When you reach the park, look for Mr. Kanthak. There are no reserved tables, but we plan to come early and claim the tables in the lower area near the river and ball field. (Be sure to have a picnic blanket in case we don't get the tables.)

### What to bring

Please bring a side dish or a dessert for the pot luck table. (Salads, chips, beans, cookies, etc.—show off your home made goodies or keep it simple with store-bought.)

Bring your own main dish. There are a few grills built in at the park. If you want to barbecue you'll need to bring charcoal. If you have a portable grill, you might prefer to bring it.

Bring your own beverages. (Sorry, this is a city park and **ALCOHOL IS NOT ALLOWED. NO BEER.**)

Remember to bring plates & forks. You will need them for some of the dishes on the pot luck table.

You may also wish to bring: lawn chairs, blankets, swimsuits & towels, inner tubes, rafts, life vests, Frisbees, squirt guns, dry clothes, and any other "picnic stuff" you can think of.

**The Water Fight** *Mark your squirt guns and other toys with your name!*

All though rain will cancel the picnic, rain or shine we are planning a group water fight. Bring your favorite water weapon: squirt gun, bucket, wet sponges, etc. Kids resent it when parents decide to join in and commandeer their weapons, so be sure to bring one for everyone. (If you bring water balloons you must pick up all the broken pieces of balloon.) **NO SQUIRTING IN THE FOOD AREA!**

### Water Balloon Launcher

Recently we have added another little event to the picnic: we have constructed a water balloon launcher that will launch a water balloon almost 100 yards. The kids line up on the other side of the baseball field and we try to get them wet.

### Park Features

The Washougal River runs through the park. There is a small sandy beach suitable for wading and sunning. There is a gentle "rapids" rafting area and a deeper area for swimming. A hiking trail runs along the river.

Swings, a slide, a climbing fort, and merry-go-round make up a playground down by the river. There are also two baseball diamonds, volleyball posts, And a restroom in this lower level.

In the upper level of the park there is another restroom, a tennis/handball court, basketball hoop, more swings, a jungle gym, and lots of grass and trees.
